The candidate for the Churchbridge Credit Union Post-Secondary Scholarship will be evaluated on the following categories:

- Integrity, Leadership and/or Mentorship to Younger Students
- Volunteer Work/Job Experience
- 🛎 Academics

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates for the Churchbridge Credit Union Post-Secondary Scholarship will be chosen based on the following eligibility requirements and selection process:

- Must be a member of the Churchbridge Credit Union or have a parent that has been a member for at least one year;
- The candidate must be selected on a basis of **community involvement**, **extra-curricular activities**, **integrity, leadership, volunteer work and academic achievement**;
- Candidate must have completed one year at a post-secondary institution and must be returning to post-secondary within the same calendar year. Qualifying post-secondary institutions are any University, Institute of Applied Science and Technology, and/or Business College. Proof of acceptance, proof of enrolment, and proof of full-time equivalence into a post-secondary institution will be required;
- Scholarship is available to members who have completed at least one year of studies at an approved postsecondary institution, continuing their studies. Preference will be given to those enrolled in Business, Business Administration, Business Ag, Commerce, Finance, Accounting, Human Resources, Information Technology, Marketing or Agriculture in the Fall of 2022; however, all courses will be considered;
- Complete an essay of approximately 500 words on the following topic: Explain why credit unions are now, more than ever, relevant in today's society.

SELECTION

- The recipient of the scholarship will be determined by the Churchbridge Credit Union selection committee.
- The candidate will be chosen based on the recipient's demonstration of community involvement, extracurricular activities, integrity, leadership, volunteer work, and academic achievement.
- * The candidate must be returning to a post-secondary institution after completing a successful year.
- The candidate must provide proof of academics and proof of enrolment for additional year.

- 3. Attach proof of enrollment at an approved post-secondary institution and a copy of your most recent academic transcripts

Guidelines for scholarship applicants:

- 1. The scholarship is available to members or children of members, board members and staff at Churchbridge Credit Union
- Scholarship is available to members who have completed at least one year of studies at an approved postsecondary institution, continuing their studies. Preference will be given to those enrolled in Business, Business Administration, Business Ag, Commerce, Finance, Accounting, Human Resources, Information Technology, Marketing or Agriculture in the Fall of 2022; however, other courses will be considered.
- **3.** Essay quality and academic merit are the top considerations in awarding the scholarship.
- 4. Evidence of marks and proof of enrollment must be included in the application package.
- **5.** All application forms are to be returned to Churchbridge Credit Union no later than May 31, 2022, without exception.
- 6. Scholarship applications may have their name, photograph, and essay published in the Churchbridge Credit Union newsletter, on the Churchbridge Credit Union website, in-branch, and on the Churchbridge Credit Union Social Media pages.
- **7.** Scholarship winners will be notified by phone after the selection in June. The scholarship will be presented before the start of the fall term.
